A556 - Chester Road, Cuddington/Sandiway - 28th May, 1st June & 6th-7th June 2024 - 09:00 – 15:30 – 18:00-20:00

A556 – Chester Road, Oakmere – 29th May, 2nd June, 10th June - 09:00 – 15:30 – 18:00-20:00

A559 – Chester Road, Hartford – 23rd-28th May, 30th May-1st June, 3rd-6th June 2024 09:00 – 15:30 – 18:00-20:00

Please ensure all vehicles are removed from the road during any works dates between the hours of 08:45 – 15:15 – 17:45-20:00

A556 & A559 Chester Road in Hartford, Cuddington and Oakmere has been identified by Cheshire West & Chester Council's Highways Service for Surface Dressing Works. This treatment is a three-phased road maintenance process which involves preparation, laying a thin layer over the top of the existing road to seal the surface to restore grip and relaying the road markings. This treatment will extend the active lifespan of the road.

During the works, a road closure will be in force to ensure the safety of both the public and the workforce. Vehicle access for residents and businesses will be maintained where possible but may be subject to short delays while works progress. Pedestrian access to properties will be maintained at all times.

There are two phases required for surface treatment work which need to take place under road closures:

1. Phase 1: Surface treatment works – this is where we apply the surface dressing.
2. Phase 2: Chipping sealing works – sealing works are usually carried out a few days after the initial surface dressing work.
3. Phase 3: Relaying road markings – Carried out after the dressing work

Please note: This is a weather-dependent operation, and dates may change subject to unfavourable weather conditions. Any changes to dates of work will be communicated via the on-site information boards and on the Council website, as above.

It will be necessary to ensure that no vehicles are parked within the works area during the working hours. If you require any urgent access by vehicle during these times, you may be best parking outside of the works area so as not to be delayed whilst the works are ongoing.

We appreciate that this work will cause some disruption. 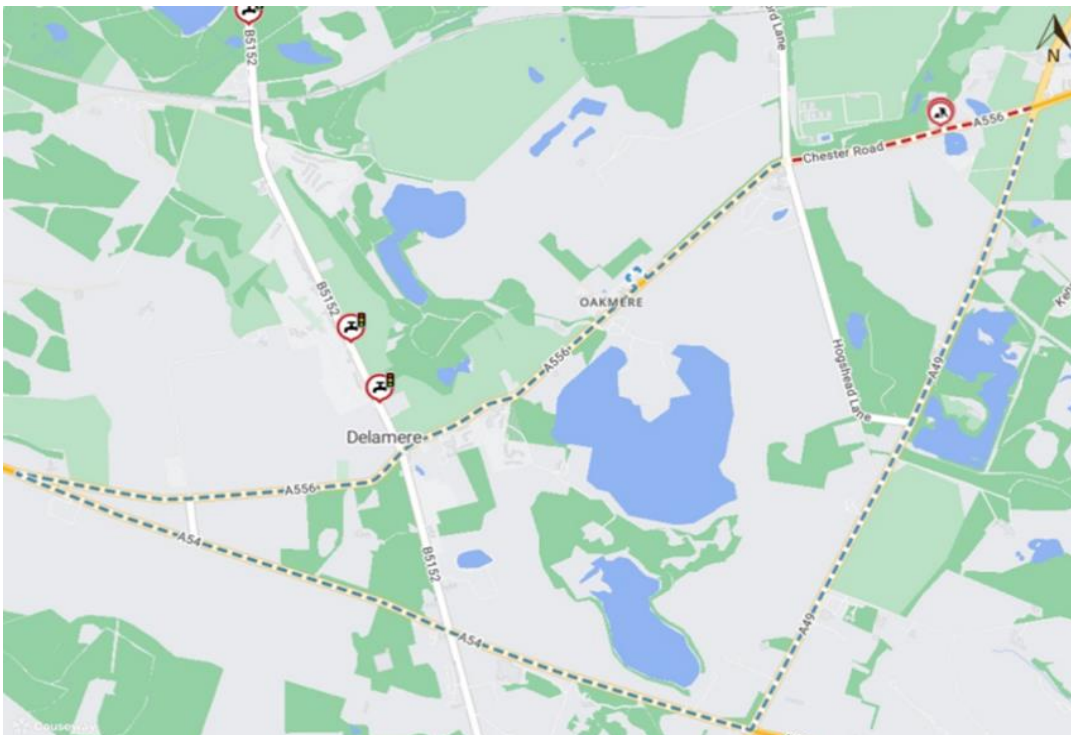

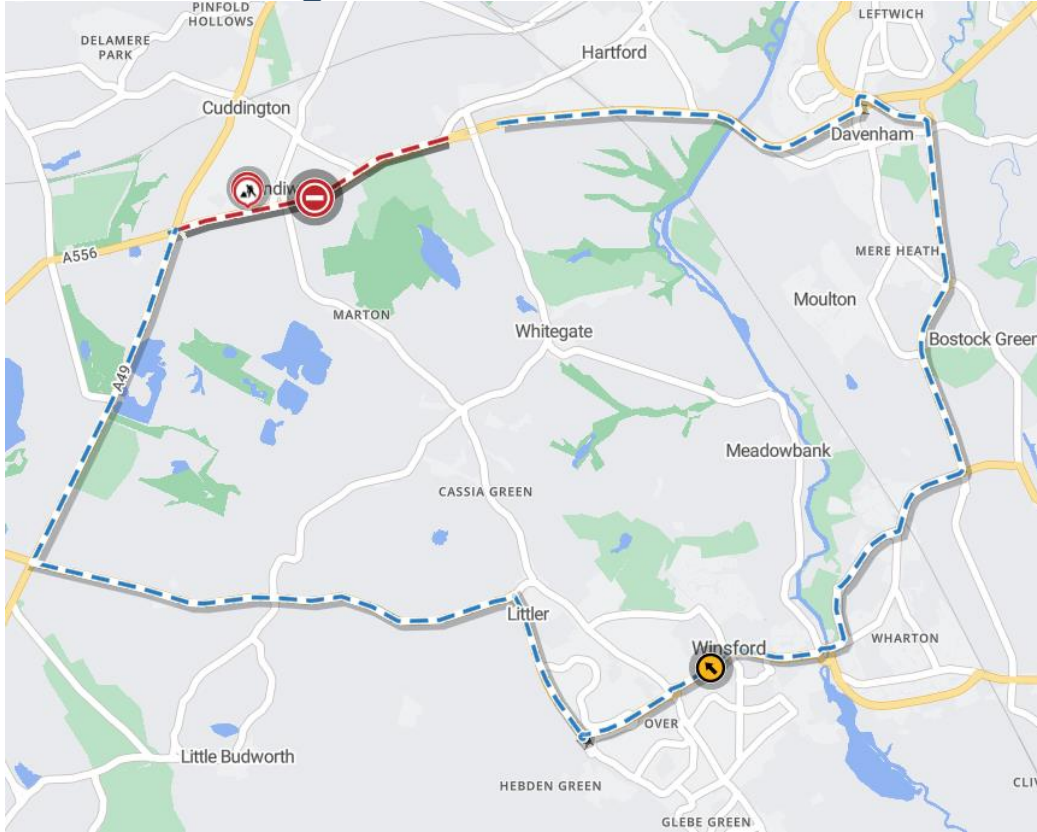
DIVERSION ROUTE PLANS

A556 Oakmere Section

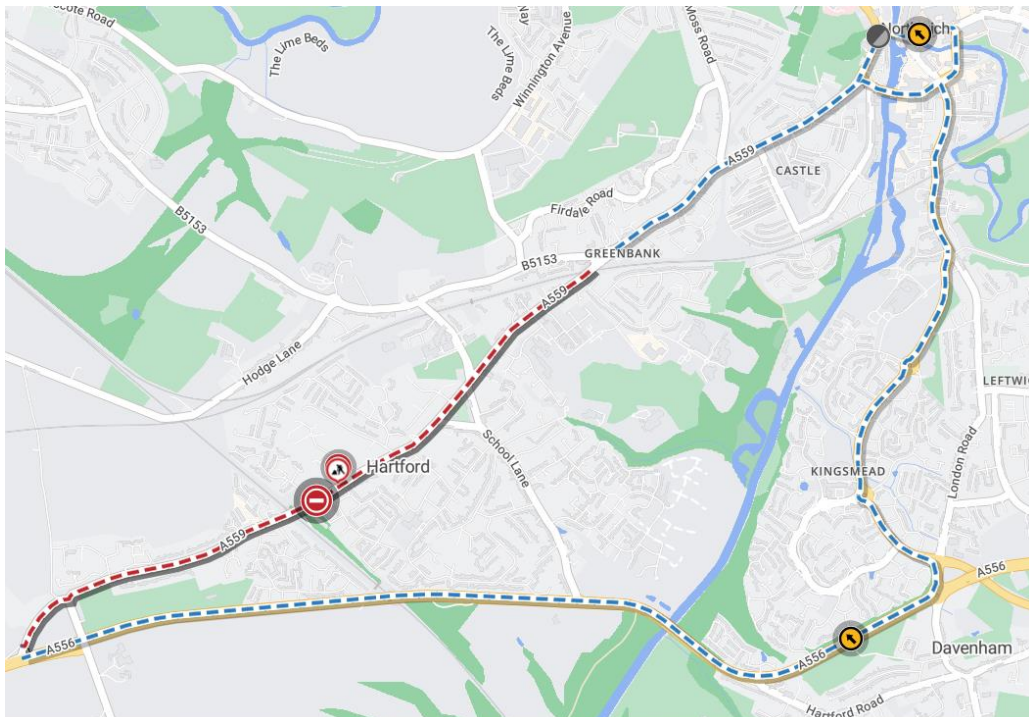
